State Secretary Report – Suzan Adams

Sherri discussed people calling in after the end of call in time. She had calls up to 11:00 pm. This will be addressed at the mandatory contestants meeting. Entries for Medicine Lodge are approximately 550.

We will look for a volunteer to do backup points for this year. Sherri and Suzan will try to identify someone. Suzan will give the spreadsheet that she designed that calculates drops to the volunteer.

Committee/Volunteers

Suzan Adams has volunteers for all committees except for the banners. Wayne Whiting will ask for a volunteer to be responsible for carrying and hanging the banners at every rodeo.

Canned Food Drive

The student officers will promote the canned food drive and encourage students to bring at least 2 canned goods per rodeo to help the local food bank. They will talk about it at the meeting and Suzan will help remind people in the membership emails and on the website.

Results of Awards versus Coat Survey

Suzan reported that the overwhelming majority of contestants wanted to do away with the lower placed awards and give coats to all contestants who attend the state finals. The response rate was good on the survey with about 82% of the contestants voted to have coats. We will discuss this further at the mid-winter meeting when we know what the budget will be.

Team Cinch

Team Cinch members were announced and contracts will be handed out at Greensburg. A team captain must be chosen. It can be a boy or girl, but we had to choose only one. A procedure was discussed on how to choose this person. It was decided to narrow the choices down to seniors. Among those seniors the board discussed who the person should be. Shawn Hollenbeck moved that we choose Wade Perry as our team captain. Casey Adams 2nd the motion. Motion passed.

Fundraisers

Wayne discussed the Casey's card and why it was decided not to make it mandatory. Jeff Van Petten moved that we have the Casey's Convenience store cards as an option fundraiser. Chad Wiswell 2nd this motion. Motion passed.

We will offer the Casey's cards at the Greensburg rodeo and they will be due by

Emporia. Shelly Whiting will distribute the cards to those who want to help sell them. She will keep a record of who took them and how many. Contestants will be responsible for all the cards that they take. If they don't sell them, they can turn them back in. If they lose the cards, they will be responsible for paying for them. The cards are \$15.00 a piece.

MISC.

A contestant was found to have turned in a falsified grade card with their membership packet. Discussion was held on this. The contestant was entered in the Medicine Lodge rodeo and was not allowed to compete. The contestant will be responsible for stock and office fees for Medicine Lodge. Brad Bailey moved that we retain the contestant's \$150.00 membership fee and if the contestant becomes eligible for the spring rodeos, then we will allow them to compete. He would need to pay the stock and office fee from Medicine Lodge and prior turnout fees. Wade Perry 2nd the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn was made at 8:45 p.m. and was passed unanimously.
