Welcome to the 2011-2012 Kansas Junior High School Rodeo Season!! We are preparing for the fall season, and it promises to be a great one. Please feel free to contact me via email suzan@ksu.edu at any time if questions arise. Email is my preferred contact.

- The following pages contain forms and list documents that are required to be filled out and returned to me as soon as possible **prior to entering your first rodeo**. In other words, I must have these forms in my office before you can call in to enter the rodeo you wish to compete. **There is a checklist on the KJHSRA state membership form that will ensure that you have all of the forms and documents needed before mailing it to me. The first rodeo of the season will be at Greensburg on Sept. 10-11, 2011.**
- Points **DO NOT** start accumulating until you are a paid member.
- **Everyone must call-in or email to get entered into the first rodeo.** The call in date for Greensburg is Wednesday, August 31 from 6-9 pm. Your rodeo secretary is Suzan Adams and the call in number is 785-238-7192. You can also email your entries in anytime on August 31st UP TO call in time. The email address is suzan@ksu.edu (please note the Z in the spelling of suzan and do not put an s as it gets delivered to someone else on the KSU campus). If you do not get an email confirmation back that your entries were received, then you are **NOT** entered and you must call in at the appropriate times to enter. No entries left on the answering machine will be accepted.
- **Sunday morning at Greensburg, Sept. 11, there will be a MANDATORY contestant meeting after Church services in the grandstands (church is at 8:30). Roll call may be taken.**
- Membership packets will be ready to be picked up at the first rodeo starting at 9 a.m. Your cards, back numbers, and other important information will be included in these packets. Back numbers must be worn on contestants backs at all times during the weekend. This means everywhere you go.
- Our official newspaper is the Rodeo News. Everything will be posted in Rodeo News, so check your paper for any updates. We also have a website; it is located at <http://www.khsra.net/jrhigh.html>. Membership input is always welcomed and appreciated for news articles in the Rodeo News or the association newsletters. Please let me know.
- Cowboy Church is held every Sunday morning at 8:30am.

Enclosed is a schedule with details about each rodeo. We are co-sanctioned with the high school rodeos (KHSRA) and information for those rodeos is on the sheet as well. We have 3 fall rodeos and those are 1), Greensburg, Sept 10-11, 2) Concordia, Oct 1-2, 3) Emporia, Oct 15-16. You can ignore the other two rodeos on the sheet as they pertain to high school contestants only. Please retain this schedule for your reference. The spring 2012 schedule will be set in early February.
